This is a restricted entry program. Students must first be accepted as an apprentice with the Illinois Laborers' and Contractors' Joint Apprenticeship and Training Program (ILCJATP). All LBR-prefix courses are taken with the union according to the apprenticeship cycle. All other courses are taken with Shawnee Community College. SCC has an articulation agreement with Southern Illinois University-Carbondale for the Bachelors in Technical Resource Management program. Interested students should seek advisement.
